10th Annual Alberta Street Art Hop

Saturday, May 16th, from 11AM until 6PM!

Art on Alberta will be closing the road for this year's event from the 12th block to the end of 29th although the cross streets of 15th and 27th will be open to traffic. With the road closure it allows for vendors to be placed in the section of the street otherwise used for parking.

The closed section of Alberta Street has been broken into 4 Zones with assigned Team Leaders:

Zone: Green	Blocks: 12 th - 15 th	Team Leaders: Tamara Kent
Zone: Hot Pink	Blocks: 16 th - 20 th	Team Leader: Mary Anne Locke
Zone: Orange	Blocks: 21 st - 24 th	Team Leader: Lori Ebeling
Zone: Blue	Blocks: 25 th - 29 th	Team Leader: Diane Pinsonault

There will be 4-6 stages placed through the venue filled with performing artists ranging from musicians, bands, neighborhood choirs, and spoken word.

Each vendor space will be \$50 for artists and \$100 for food vendors. Food vendors, please remember to get your Temporary Restaurant License from Multnomah County. The assigned space will roughly be a 10' x 12' area. Vendors will need to supply their own tables, materials and electricity for the event. These reserved spots are for the showing and/or sale of hand-crafted items only and we ask that the artist be present. No imported handicrafts, please.

If vendors sign up and pay prior to May 1, 2009, they will be listed in full page advertising prior to event.

The day of the event the Vendor Check-In will be located at 20th and NE Alberta. Vendors registering by April 30, 2009 will receive their credentials and location information via the USPS by May 10th. Everyone registering after April 30, 2009 will need to stop at the vendor check-in to be assigned their area and given credentials to be displayed in their booth for the duration of the event. Vendors are ONLY allowed to set up in their assigned areas and not on the sidewalks nor on the street in front of businesses.
